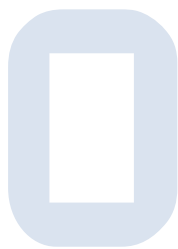
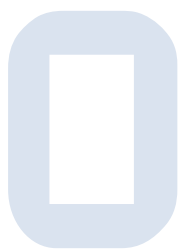

Manufacturing Excellence Village

The Manufacturing Excellence Village is located at the centre of MAeX and is meant for companies that wish to have a stand at MAeX2010 with a limited investment.

Stands are 12 m² or 16 m² and come with a central meeting area and a kitchen (fridge, coffeemaker and storage shelves). Stands include carpeting, adequate lightning, a table with three chairs, 2.2 kW power supply, a bar with a bar stool, a brochure display unit, daily stand maintenance, a permanent parking card for private cars, a liability insurance and ½ page in the catalogue. Handling fees and the renting of the stand area are included in the price below.

The Manufacturing Excellence Village stands are grouped and their walls and carpeting have individualised colours, in order for this zone to be clearly recognisable.

- I choose a 12 m² "all in" stand in the Manufacturing Excellence Village priced at € 2500.
- I choose a 16 m² "all in" stand in the Manufacturing Excellence Village priced at € 3200.

According to the respective type of stand indicated on the plan, namely row, corner, head or island stand, the stands have 1, 2, 3 or 4 open sides.

A. Participation costs and stand area

B. Assignment of stand locations

In assigning the stand locations, as much consideration as possible will be given to the preference of the exhibitor-candidate indicated on the registration form. However, the organiser is not obligated by the preference indicated by the exhibitor. The organiser reserves the ultimate right to assign definitive stand locations and to do so in the general interest of the participants. The exhibitor will be notified of the exact location of the stand in the letter of acceptance.

Insofar as the distribution of groups in the exhibition halls conforms to that of the previous exhibition, previously participating exhibitors shall have priority regarding the choice of stand location.

C. Catalogue

I agree to underwrite 1/2 page (A4) of publicity in color in the Metapro 2010/MAeX catalogue. This is included in the fixed administrative fee.

D. Assurance

I agree to submit the order form for the compulsory all-risks insurance for the stand and its contents. This compulsory service may be waived if the exhibitor already has an insurance policy providing the same cover, provided that a copy of this policy is submitted to the organizers. The obligatory Exhibitor Liability Insurance is included in the fixed administrative fee.

E. Service Brochure

The agreement between the organiser and the exhibitor regards the hire of a stand and a service package. The services brochure, which contains a complete list and full details of both the compulsory services (insurance, catalogue, etc.) and the optional services (hire of furniture etc.), will be sent to the exhibitor in a timely fashion by the organizers. The requirements listed in this service brochure are an integral part of the agreement concluded between the parties.

F. Settlement agreement

By signing the registration form, the applicant makes a firm commitment to participate as an exhibitor. The agreement between the organiser and the exhibitor is settled when the organiser sends a letter of acceptance to the exhibitor. This will include the number of the stand allotted to him and any special conditions or specifications. The date of the acceptance shall be taken as the date on which the agreement was made. An initial invoice for the deposit may be sent to the exhibitor along with the letter of acceptance.

G. Annulation

Exhibitors obliged to cancel their participation must inform the organisers by registered post. The exhibitor remains liable for the full amount due for hiring the stand space, and also alts due for services already provided, even if these have not yet been invoices to the exhibitor, and without prejudice to the organisers' right to full compensation. Upon cancellation, the organisation has the right to re-assign the stand and to hire it out again. If, for whatever reason, the stand is not hired out again, the costs of decorating the vacant stand will be assessed. The right to hire out stands rests solely with the organisers of Metapro.

H. Payment

- The exhibitor undertakes to pay half of the amount due and the balance within 8 days of receiving the invoice, into the financial account named on the invoice.
- Failure to settle an invoice in full by the due date shall by law automatically cancel any postponement of the due date for payment for the other services or supplies; which means that these payments are due immediately.
- All costs that stem from payments made by or to a foreign exhibitor, for example related bank charges, will be borne by the exhibitor.

I. General conditions Metapro

Art. 1 By concluding an agreement with us, the client acknowledges to recognise the present terms and to accept them as an integral component thereof. We do not recognise any other terms that may exist in the documents of the client, either general or specific.

Art. 2 Each agreement is concluded under the assumption of good references, and we continuously maintain the right to postpone an agreement and to request complete proof of guarantee for the proper execution thereof.

Art. 3 Each dispute related to an invoice must be submitted in writing with 8 days following the receipt of the invoice; otherwise they shall be inadmissible. Barring written counterevidence, the date of the invoice shall serve and the date of receipt of the invoice. Belgian law shall apply. Disputes shall fall under the jurisdiction of the legal authorities of Kortrijk. Responses to disputes submitted after this time shall imply no omission of this condition, and all rights are reserved in perpetuity and without prejudice.

Art. 4 When a dispute is recognised, either between the parties or in court, our responsibility shall be limited to the replacement or crediting of the invoiced amount and any compensation shall be excluded and/or shall be repudiated by the client.

Art. 5 The invoices are, barring explicitly differing conditions, payable in cash to the business office in Harelbeke, without discount. In the case of non-payment, an annual interest rate of 12% will be levied on the amounts owed, in a legally binding manner and without necessity of prior notice.

Furthermore, in case of whole or partial non-payment of the amount owed on the date due, without bona fide reasons, after notice of default is served, the amount due will be increased by 15%, by a minimum of € 75 and a maximum of € 2000, even after a grace period has been granted.

All collections fees and costs of dispute will always be borne by the client, and the acceptance of bills of exchange does not bring about a renewal of a debt.

Art. 6 The relationships between the contracting parties shall be governed by Belgian law. Each dispute shall fall under the jurisdiction of the legal authorities of Kortrijk. Solely the organisers of Metapro may deviate from this rule.

Art.7 Orders of potential services or changes to existing orders will be accepted only if the order form is sent to us via e-mail, fax or regular mail. Verbal changes will only be noted accompanied by an official document from the eXPo-kit.

Art.8 The editorial contributions, contact information and information regarding products and brands make up part of this contract. This information must be sent using the forms provided via e-mail (text in Word, logos in 300 dpi .jpeg format).

Art.9 Receptions, breakfast, informational meetings and all other possible side events make up part of the cost of participation within the provisions of this contract.

Art.10 Unless explicitly agreed to in writing beforehand by the organiser, the exhibitor is not allowed to assign the rights and obligations conferred by this agreement to third parties.

Art.11 In case the organisers of Metapro decide not to organise the exhibition for any reason, including force majeure, the exhibitor is solely entitled to the repayment of deposits and invoices already paid, and shall not be entitled to make a claim to compensation of any kind. Moreover, the organisation retains the right, with no rights to compensation on the part of the exhibitors, to decide to extend, postpone or curtail the exhibition ahead of time, or to move it to a time and place to the benefit and advantage of the exhibition.

In case cancellation by the organisers occurs at least six months prior to the start of the exhibition, the amounts already charged will be credited and eventual payments received will be refunded. In case the cancellation occurs at a later date, a pro rata amount of costs already incurred by the organiser will be deducted.

Payment of invoices related to provisions and services already delivered shall also be required.

The exhibitor agrees to comply with the decisions of the organiser in all cases not provided for in the general terms at hand or in the particular terms indicated in the registration form, which make up an integral part of the agreement concluded between the parties.

Art.12 The organiser retains the right to make changes to the general arrangements, on a continuous basis, as is useful or necessary, including the addition or removal of passageways, the expansion or reduction of same, and in general, to modify the dimensions of the spaces made available. These changes shall not entitle the exhibitor to compensation or to relocate the stand.

Art.13 The construction, decoration and clearing of the stand shall occur at the expense, risk and responsibility of the exhibitor. The organisation shall under no circumstances be held liable for any potential accidents or losses occurring as a result.

The exhibitor hereby affirms acknowledgement of the above terms and conditions. The exhibitor accepts these explicitly and without reservation, and expressly waives the applicability of his own general terms and conditions.
